


Embracing Resilience in Patient Organization Projects

Covid 19 Crisis 2020 - 2022

- Providing information for Patients: Provide up-to-date information and guidance to cancer patients about COVID-19.
- Medication Delivery: Implement door-to-door delivery of medications to minimize patients' need to visit the hospital.
- Education: Maintain educational programs and activities through virtual platforms.
- Collaborations: Work with all stakeholders to address the negative impacts of COVID-19 on cancer patients and their families.
- Adapting to Post-COVID Changes: Plan for future changes, such as incorporating telemedicine and tele-consultation into regular services.
 Data: Collect data to understand the specific and urgent needs of cancer patients during the pandemic.
- Financial Assistance: Offer financial assistance for patients facing economic challenges due to the pandemic.



Earthquake Crisis September 2023

- New Partnerships: Engage with local Businesses and international NGOs (House Insurance and repair works).
- Funding sources: Accept Financial donations, in-kind support, volunteer assistance, and expertise.
- Enhanced services: Introduce weekly visits from a psychologist and a monthly grant of 500 € for blood tests.
- Media Engagement: Extend interview invitations to local newspapers and radio stations to share the inspiring story of Dar Al Amal and encourage community support.
- Sustained Communication: Maintain consistent communication with partners and donors, keeping them informed about the tangible effects of their contributions, Dar Al Amal's ongoing repairs and future opportunities for involvement.
